A PERSPECTIVE FROM THE 60TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE TRACTS OF ROME

This year is celebrated the 60th anniversary of the Tracts of Rome. On March 25, 1957, they signed the Constitutive Tract of the European Economic Community (EEC) and the Constitutive Tract of the European Atomic Energy Community (CEEA or Euratom). These two tracts, together with the Constitutive Tract of the European Coal and Steel Community (CECA), have historically been considered as the constitutive tracts of the European Communities.

The objectives of this seminar will be to analyze the challenges that the European Union faces in these proper years, having regard to the trajectory and canvis viscuts in these 60 years. Here, issues related to the refugee crisis, the impact of Brexit, the European Veinage Policy, the security and defense of the EU, the TTIP and the action of the EU in the construction of peace in Colombia will be dealt with.
